



25 May 2019 - American Legion Post 29 hosted the 5th Annual Veterans Memorial 5K Run/Walk, 1K Run/Walk and Tot Trot with a start/finish at Marietta Square. The event was a huge success!

The Horace Orr American Legion Post 29 is part of the federally chartered veteran services organization established One Hundred Years Ago in 1919 and is located in Marietta, GA. The year 2019 also marks the 100th Anniversary of the American Legion as an organization.

Mr. Walt Cusick is the Commander of Post 29 and Mr. Tom Bell is the Vice Commander and Race Committee Chair and Mrs Peggy Beascoechea served as the Deputy Race Committee Chair. The Veterans Memorial 5K Race continues to be a wonderful family-friendly event that is well organized because of the hard work and commitment of many Legion members, volunteers and participants as well as the generous support of great sponsors!



HONORING OUR HEROES - PAST, PRESENT, FALLEN

Prior to the Race this year, Post 29 hosted a series of pre-race events which included an American Legion Riders motorcycle ride on 27 April 2019; a wine-tasting afternoon at the Marietta Wine Market on 11 May 2019 and an awesome Banks & Shane Concert on 16 May 2019 at the Strand Theater.

Net proceeds from the Race are designated for the Service Office of American Legion Post 29, the Shepherd's Men SHARE Military Initiative at the Shepherd Spinal Clinic in Atlanta and the Georgia National Guard Foundation.

Special guests at the Race included members of The Shepherd's Men, an awesome group who raise awareness about suicide prevention, post-traumatic stress disorders and traumatic brain injuries in association with the Shepherd's Center in Atlanta.

Leadership from the Georgia National Guard, including Major General Tom Carden, The Adjutant General; Brig General Randall Simmons, Commanding General of the Georgia Army National Guard; Brig General Reg Neal, Director Joint Staff; COL Dwayne Wilson, Chief of Staff; and other military leaders and members led the way for the Race this year as a show of support for the Georgia National Guard Foundation.

The Foundation is a non-profit 501(c) (3) corporation governed by a Board of Directors and it is recognized as an official support organization of the Georgia National Guard. It is self-funded and totally relies on donations and fund-raising events to provide emergency relief assistance to current members of the Georgia National Guard facing unexpected financial hardships.

The Georgia National Guard Recruiting and Retention Team, one of the sponsors of the event, did an outstanding job with participation and static displays again this year. In addition, the R&R Team facilitated a truly special part of the event by coordinating a live simulcast with Georgia Army National Guard troops deployed in Afghanistan. Runners, supporters and family members had the opportunity to exchange greetings prior to the Race. Almost 100 runners in Afghanistan then participated in the actual race in real time.

CSM Jason York, from Dallas, GA, has run the Veterans Memorial 5K in years past. He and 1SG Andy Keene, led the way for their troops (in two different Afghan locations) to participate this year. After the Opening Ceremony of the Race which included remarks by Commander Cusick, Mr. Tom Bell and Brig General Randall Simmons, the call went out to CSM York to officially START the Race with a coordinated count-down at 7:30 am! It was pure excitement! CSM York is quoted in the Marietta Daily Journal as saying, "It's an honor and privilege to be halfway around the world and still participate with America's finest back home and with our hometown heroes, the American Legion Post 29 and the Georgia National Guard."

Following the Race, a Military Appreciation Celebration featuring the Georgia Symphony Orchestra performed patriotic music at Glover Park in the Marietta Square. The Opening Ceremony included remarks by Commander Walt Cusick, Mr Tom Bell, Cobb County Commission Chairman Mike Boyce and Maj General Tom Carden. The event was well attended and appreciated by all as a great way to recognize Memorial Day.
