

Foundation Report 2021

The Georgia National Guard Family Support Foundation, Inc. was established in 1994 and approved by the Internal Revenue Service as a non-profit 501 (c) (3) charitable corporation in 1996. Governed by a voluntary Board of Directors, its primary mission is to provide assistance on an emergency relief basis to current members of the Georgia National Guard and full-time federal/state civilian employees of the Georgia Department of Defense facing unexpected financial hardships.

Although not a military organization, the Foundation is recognized as an official support organization of the Georgia National Guard. It is self-funded and relies totally on individual and corporate donations, charity partners and fundraising events, to support its mission.

It is one of nine "check-off" charities approved by the Legislature for the State of Georgia Department of Revenue to collect donations on its Tax Forms. This designation gives every taxpayer in Georgia the opportunity to "pick an amount and make it count" for the Georgia National Guard Foundation when filing their State Income Tax Form 500 or 500 EZ. Look for it!

The Foundation is an approved charity for the Combined <u>Federal</u> Campaign (CFC agency code # 70602) and the <u>State</u> Charitable Contributions Program (SCCP agency code # IN000600). Charity fest events and kick-off opportunities, including universal online giving, are opportunities for support.

The funeral was held on Friday, March 26th, at 11:00 AM at Blessed Sacrament Catholic Church with burial and military honors to follow at Bonaventure Cemetery in Savannah. The family held a visitation at Baker McCullough Funeral Home at 6:00 PM on Thursday, March 25th. He grew up in Norcross. He enlisted in the US Army Reserve in 2000. He then transferred to the Georgia Army National Guard in 2004 and served his country for over 20 years. Alex was married to Elizabeth McIntyre on October 23, 2010.

Alex's main career was that of a professional soldier. Alex was deployed to two major theaters of operation. His first deployment was to Kuwait in support of the 2003 invasion of Iraq. His second deployment was to Bagdad, Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. His third deployment was to Afghanistan in support of Operation Enduring Freedom.

Alex was awarded the Combat Infantry Badge in Iraq and the Bronze Star Medal for actions in combat in Afghanistan. Alex achieved the rank of Sergeant First Class and was admired by his peers and subordinates alike.

Alex was an avid Falcons fan, who never wanted to miss a game. Alex loved the outdoors, and he and Elizabeth loved camping in the North Georgia Mountains, and exercising with their two dogs, Stella and Able.

Survivors include his wife, Elizabeth McIntyre-Hytowitz; parents, Allan, and Sarah Gail Hytowitz; brother, Neil Hytowitz; and in-laws, Michael and Marjorie McIntyre. A memorial service was held on Sunday, August 1 at 4:00 pm at Temple Sinai followed by interment with honors at the Georgia National Cemetery.
