

Foundation Report 2022

The Georgia National Guard Family Support Foundation, Inc. was established in 1994 and approved by the Internal Revenue Service as a Non-Profit 501 (c) (3) charitable corporation in 1996. Governed by a voluntary Board of Directors, its primary mission is to provide financial assistance on an emergency relief basis to current members of the Georgia National Guard and eligible full-time federal/state civilian employees of the Georgia Department of Defense facing unexpected hardships. It is recognized as an official support organization of the Georgia National Guard.

Individual and corporate donations and the impact and success of our fundraising events make a difference in the lives of many Soldiers and Airmen of the Georgia National Guard facing unexpected financial hardships.

It is one of nine "check-off" charities approved by the Legislature for the State of Georgia Department of Revenue to collect donations on its Tax Forms. This designation gives every taxpayer in Georgia the opportunity to "pick an amount and make it count" for the Georgia National Guard Foundation when filing their State Income Tax Form 500 or 500 EZ. Look for it!

The Foundation is an approved charity for the State Charitable Contributions Program (SCCP agency code # IN000600). Charity fest events and kick-off opportunities, including online giving, are opportunities for support. The Foundation also participates in the annual GA Gives on Giving Tuesday event as part of the State of Georgia's effort to recognize Non-Profit organizations.

70TH ANNUAL ARMAC MILITARY APPRECIATION LUNCHEON

McConville, 40th Chief of Staff of the U.S. Army on November 7th at the Cobb Galleria. Gen. McConville assumed duty as the 40th chief of staff of the U.S. Army on August 9, 2019, after most recently serving as the 36th Vice Chief of Staff of the U.S. Army.

Gen. McConville is a senior Army aviator qualified in the AH-64 D Longbow Apache, OH-58 Kiowa Warrior, AH-6, AH-1 Cobra, and other aircraft. His command assignments as the 40th Chief of Staff of the U.S. Army include commanding general of the 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault), where he also served as the commanding general of Combined Joint Task Force-101, Operation Enduring Freedom, commander of 4th Brigade, 1st Calvary Division, Operation Iraqi Freedom; commander of 2nd squadron, 17th Calvary Regiment, just to name a few.

Some of his key staff assignments include the U.S. Army deputy chief of staff, G-1; chief of Legislative Liaison; executive officer to the vice chief of staff of the Army; G-3 for 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault); J5 strategic planner for U.S. Special Operations Command. Gen. McConville is the recipient of two Distinguished Service Medals, three Legions of Merit, three Bronze Stars, two Defense Meritorious Service Medals and a host of other awards and honors.

The program will also include a salute to fallen soldiers, recognition of military personnel, and the presentation of the prestigious 2022 USO Patriot of the Year Award.
